Writing

Maths

- Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 X12
- Recognise and use factor pairs
- Multiply two-digit and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number using formal written layout
- Solve problems involving multiplying and adding, to multiply two-digit numbers by one-digit
- Use place value and facts to multiply and divide mentally, to include multiplying by 1 and 0
- Divide by 1
- Multiply three numbers
- Find the area of rectilinear shapes by counting squares
- Measure and calculate the perimeter of a rectilinear shapes in cm and mm
