As readers and writers, we will learn...

- * To make meaningful marks and prepare for writing.
- * To recognise our name.
- * To hear and read some phonic sounds (m,a,s,d,i,p,g,f,e,j,k,c,o).
- * Begin to blend sounds to make 2 and 3 letter words.
- * To learn the meaning of new words linked to our learning.

Personal, social and emotional development:

As people we will learn....

- * To play with one or more children.
- * To show confidence in new social situations.
- * To follow rules and remember them.
- * To talk with others to help solve problems.
- * To build constructive and respectful relationships.
- * To begin to express feelings and consider the feelings of others.
- * To explore my emotions through play and stories.

Understanding the World:

As explorers, we will learn that...

- * To talk about members of my immediate family and community.
- * To name and describe people who are familiar to me.
- * To make connections between the features of my family and other families.
- * To name different people who help me.
- * To show an interest in different occupations

Communication and Language:

As communicators we will learn...

- * To understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.
- * To use talk to work out problems and organise thinking.
- * To ask appropriate questions and understand simple questions.

- * To start a conversation with an adult or friend.

As home learners we will learn...

As mathematicians we will learn...

- * To count up to 10.
- * To develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects (subitise).
- * To link numerals and amounts up to 5

- * To begin to use one-handed tools and equipment.
- * To use a comfortable grip when holding pens and pencils.
- * To develop balancing, riding and ball skills.
