
English

Reading

- Retrieve and record information and identify key details from fiction and non-fiction.
- Make **inferences** from the text to explain and justify, using evidence from the text.



Writing

- Use correct punctuation in all writing, including full-stops, capital letters, commas and inverted commas.
- Use colons and semi-colons correctly in writing
- Include **fronted adverbial phrases** as sentence starters to add detail to a piece of writing
- Use **subordinating conjunctions**, such as while, when, since, because, until, if
- Write using a variety of sentence lengths and structures
- To write non-fiction, information texts using key features of the text

Art / DT

- To create objects (a Viking purse) that employ a seam allowance—to use a blanket stitch.
- To use a **needle** and **thread** to sew a purse.

Maths

- To work with numbers up to 3 decimal places.
- To order **decimals** numbers.
- To find equivalent fractions to decimals to percentages.
- To round numbers to 1 decimal place.
- To calculate the perimeter and area of shapes.
- To read and interpret line graphs, tables and timetables.

Music

- Play a piece using 2 chords or more
- Compose a simple chord sequence
- Show awareness of simple chord changes and harmony

- To explore what Britain was like before the first Viking Invasion

- To find out how and when England became a Unifed Country
- To find out about the end of the Anglo-Saxon and Viking era in Britain

Science: EARTH & SPACE

- To describe the movements of the Sun, Earth and Moon
- To explore how the rotation of Earth creates day and night.
- To understand how the Earth's **tilt** creates seasons.
- To learn about the phases of the Moon.
- To discover how theories about our solar system have changed.
- To investigate the **planets** in our **solar system**.

RE
